# CLOSET LINE LAUNCHED

Northwest cabinet company Canyon Creek introduces a closet line.

Canyon Creek Cabinet Co., a custom cabinet manufacturer headquartered in Monroe, WA, introduced a new custom storage line, Closets Plus, in late April. The line is being offered through its dealer network in the Northwest United States.

"Closet systems are a natural extension of our existing business, as we already have designers and sales people working with our customers supplying cabinetry for kitchens, bathrooms, home offices, entertainment centers and more. This will allow us to provide true one-stop shopping for all their interior cabinetry and organizational needs, from a company our customers already know and trust," says Bill Weaver, Canyon Creek president and CEO. "While closets will not be our main business, it is an important component to providing our customers the products and services they expect from us, and we expect closets to be a substantial part of our business."

Closets Plus uses a suspension rail system and features almost 50 different design modules. A wood line is available in maple and cherry in five different stains, ranging from light to dark shades. There are four different wood door styles with matching drawer fronts. There also is a melamine line in white, crème and six woodgrains: caramel, chai, chocolate, Ancona walnut, western alder and Windsor mahogany. There are seven thermofoil door styles. Mullion and grid options are available in both thermofoil and wood doors.

The company offers a variety of crown mouldings, valances, columns and decorative hardware. It also offers a complete selection of standard closet accessories in various finishes and colors.
